YOUR IDENTITY STATEMENTS

What is an Identity Statement?

Identity Statements are your character statements - based on your core values and beliefs - these statements can be guideposts for you when deciding on committed action - either in career, relationships, any decision or action.

Why should I create Identity Statements?

Life gets very busy. Relationships and situations can get convoluted. Having Identity Statements can ground you and provide direction when life gets complicated. They can be helpful for the following:

- As guidance for your purpose or calling in life
- As an everyday life reminder of what is truly important to you
- As a signpost of how you want to behave in different areas of life (work, home, etc.)
- As an important factor in gaining confidence
- To ease the decision-making process by knowing yourself better
- To get to know people close to you better
- To reduce stress before important events
- As a motivation for harder tasks in life

How do I create my Identity Statements?

First, drop judgment. Do this exercise with self-awareness and in a stance of observation. Getting curious and getting focused and ambitious even. Second, go back to your values. Your identity statements should say something about what you value most. If you need help with values clarification, refer to the table below and choose your top 10.

(prioritize my family)
(takes care of their physical body)
(a person who likes to learn new things)

- 2. What would be the evidence underneath these identity statements? Factual events, your own thoughts and preferences. Sometimes we see that we would like to have an identity statement but we don't have much evidence. So we can work towards this so deficits are not necessarily "bad" at all.
- 3. Boundaries are there areas that need some boundary clarification? Boundaries = "the distance I can love both you and me at the same time."
